Peg Catapult - risk of injury from misuse of glue	Young people, other family members	Responsible adult to supervise use of glue. Activity not to take place in confined space.	
Rockets – risk of injury from misuse of scissors	Young people	Responsible adult to supervise use of scissors	
Hover Discs – risk of injury from misuse of glue	Young people, other family members	Responsible adult to supervise use of glue. Activity not to take place in confined space.	
Cork Rafts – risk of injury from use of scissors and sharp sticks	Young people, other family members	Responsible adult to supervise activity	
Feed the Ducks – risk of falling into water. Risk or injury from geese and/or swans	Young people, other family members	Responsible adult to supervise activity	
Mini-beast hunt – risk of infection, adverse reaction or internal consumption of mini-beasts, soil and animal faeces	Young people, other family members	All participants to wash their hands thoroughly at conclusion of activity
